INTRODUCTION

We surveyed the village **NAWADA** and interacted with a lot of village people. Our experience made us realize and understand the problems they face in their day to day lives. Our prime focus was to get to know if children in the village attended school or not and to aware them about the hygiene and sanitation.

INTERACTION WITH FAMILIES

Our first interaction was with Mr Ranjit and family comprising of one kid. Mr. Ranjit is a driver. The problems faced by this family was :

- Common washroom for females and males for a specific area i.e. One washroom facility for 3-4 families.
- There is no regularity of timings of water tank, thus water supply is limited and usually availed only once in the day.



Our second interaction was with Mrs Premvati and family who has been a resident of Nawada village since its establishment. They were highly distressed about the garbage collection system and sanitation issues and were worried for the health of their kids due to low pest control measures in the village.



PRIMARY SCHOOL ACTIVITY WITH CLASS 2ND AND 4TH :

Our best experience was with involvement of activities with highly enthusiastic students of two classes . We had a thrilling experience by conducting a short drawing / sketching activity , singing songs, teaching them about shapes, enjoyable direction based games , explaining them about basic hygiene i.e More usage of dustbin , washing hands before consuming food.

We distributed Chocolates, Pens, Toffees and Packets of Biscuits to the children and also to the families we met.

Lastly, We asked all the students to speak about their ambitions and dreams.



CONCLUSION:

As far as our opinions are concerned, We are glad to see that almost all the kids of the village are going to school and are also willing to learn more each day.

Also, the parents are concerned about the hygiene and education of their children.

People complained about lack of pest control measures , however they were also ready to take part in cleanliness drive for the betterment of the village.
