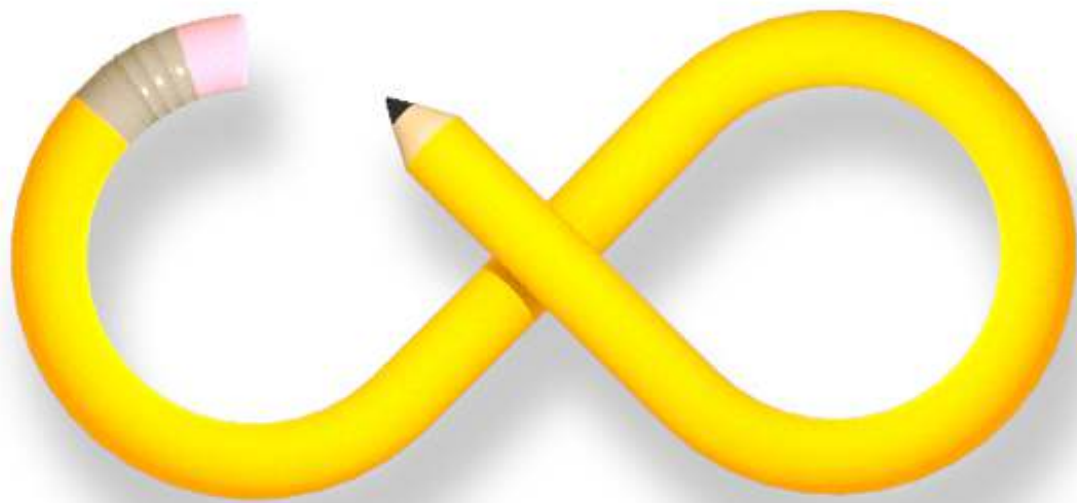

- Propose summarizing process of the year-long actions which will be presented to the next FDP gathering or at any other forum.
