**“EVERY BLOOD DONOR IS A LIFE SAVER”**

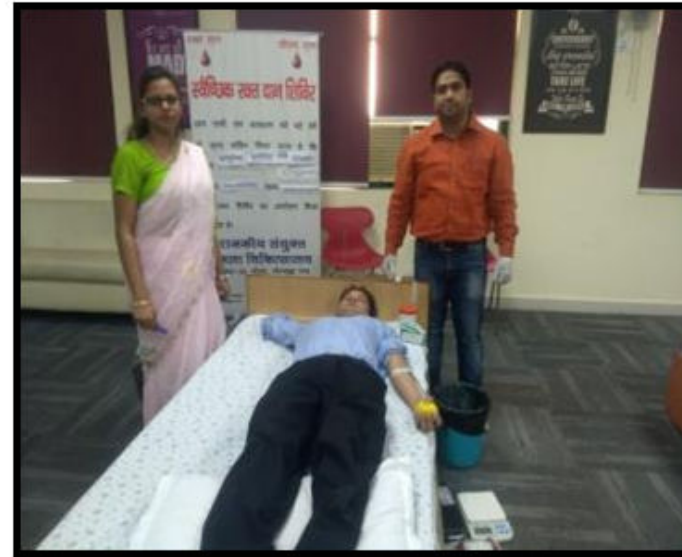
“Disha...A Ray of Hope” is the CSR committee of the Institute engaged in doing social work at its best. In the past, the committee has continuously organized blood donation camps in the campus. Every year the students voluntarily and enthusiastically come and donate blood.



Thus adhering to the tradition, similar initiative was taken by the committee wherein blood donation camp was organized on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2017 in the institute. The event took place in association with **Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Government Hospital** which is situated at Sector 30 Noida. The event ran for 5 hours wherein it started in the morning from 10 am and went on to 3pm in the afternoon. It was a free of cost campaign and it charged nothing from the students. It went on under the supervision of two doctors **Dr. Manisha** and **Dr. Shyla**. Talking about the ease of the event then it was a very simple process as it started with filling up a form, following which height and weight of the donor got checked. After which the donor was expected to give the blood in a room wherein 4 beds were lying.



If we talk from the student's point of view, then the involvement of students was highly appreciated. Students contributed for this event in great numbers. From every student one unit i.e. around 350gms of blood was collected. They were really happy after they gave their blood as they had a vision that their contribution will save someone's life.



CSR planned everything for the smooth flow of the event. Food material such as biscuits, fruits, chocolates were bought by them for the donors.

Moreover, we talked to those students who contributed in terms of giving their blood and trust us they were really satisfied as they thought that they have done good for the society. By the end of the day a total of 62 units of blood were collected.

After the blood got donated the donor was appreciated with a blood donor's certificate and also with a 1 year card with which the donor can get 1 unit of blood in any government hospital.
