GRAVITY 2017 AT JAIPURIA NOIDA

We had been waiting for the electrifying day to come, and the wait got over when Gravity 2K17 knocked our doors on 14th November, 2017. At Jaipuria Noida the event started with the registration process held in the front lawn of the campus. There were coordinators from different committees who sat with a desk for the registration of the teams for different events.



DAY 1 - 14th November, 2017

The inaugural ceremony took place with the march past of the participating colleges which was followed by the lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries present for the Inaugural session. The Chief Guests for the event were **Shri Mohd. Ghaus**, Former National Level Goalkeeper and sports commentator, two more guests who are well known in the field of Javelin Throw and Discuss Throw **Ms. Disha** and **Ms. Madhu**. The Guest of Honour was **Mr. Sachin Gupta**, a national Taekwondo player was also present to add grace in the event. After the speech was delivered by the chief guest, the Oath Ceremony took place and was declared open.
