
Udaan By Sarthak Foundation


Date of the Activity:28th August 2016

Date of Activity: Phase I (11th September 2016); Phase II & Phase II, (Dec 18, 2016)


Nature of activity: Social Initiative


Brief about the activity:

Children Day Celebration for Children from Sarthak


Date of the Activity: 14th November 2016


Digital Security Education cum Awareness Campaign


Clothes Donation Drive


Christmas Day Celebration


Date of the Activity: Dec 25,2016


Motivational Talk on Tree Plantation


Date of the activity: 28th January 2017


Manthan- Ek Pahal

Street Art


Date of the activity: March 5, 2017


Text Book Donation at Nav Srijan


Women's Day Celebration




Holi Celebration with Children Living by Roadside


Date of the activity: 22nd March 2017
