**Brief about the activity:**

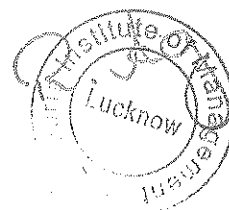
*“Life is either a daring adventure or it is nothing, be a bit daring, be a social worker.”*

The program ran for a duration of about 3 months starting in the month of July and then continuing up to October. The program in total had approximately 138 students from first year PGDM, PGDM(RM) and PGDM(FS) alike.

**Dr. Reena Agarwal Ma'am**, Chairperson, Social Responsibility Committee, our guiding pillar, and the motivation behind the initiative was there to boost up our morals at every step. The program was a success, because of her continuous guidance.

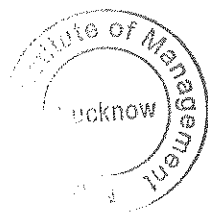

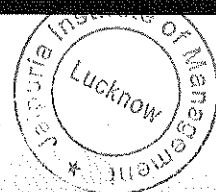
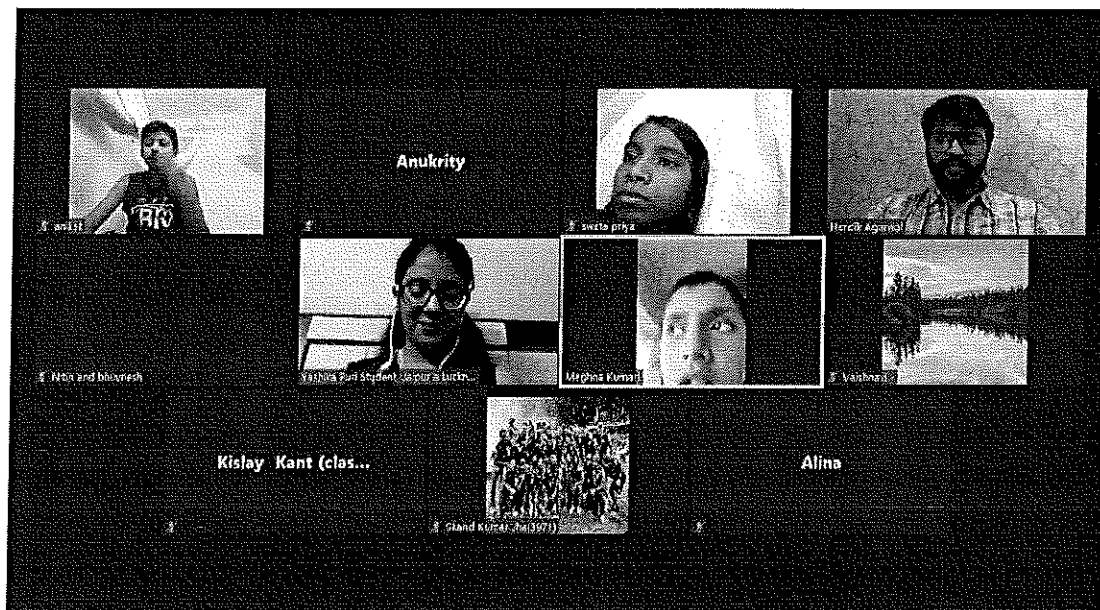

**Brief about the activity:**

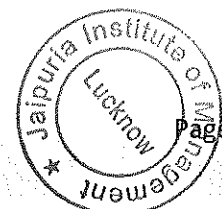
*“Giving is not just about making a donation. It is about making a difference.”*

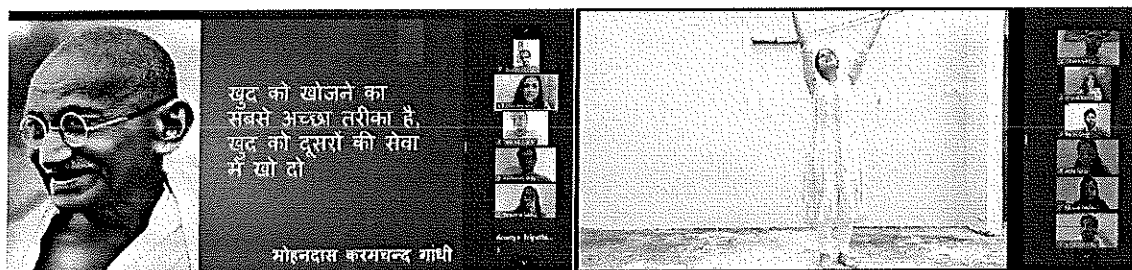
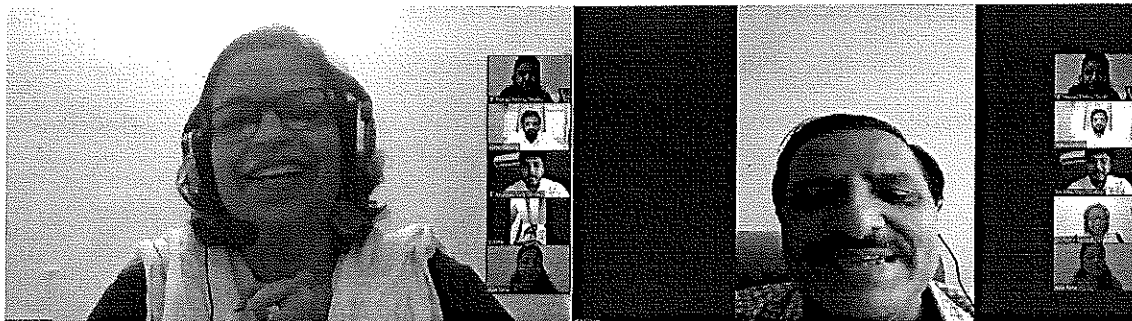
The main motive of the event was to spend some quality time with the elderly of our society, who unfortunately are living in the absence of their family members. And to show our love and respect towards them.



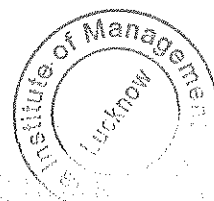

**"Sustainability is no longer about less harm; it's about doing better."**

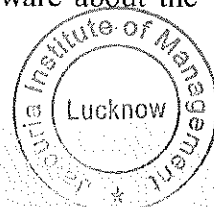

**Nature of activity:** Healthy Lifestyle

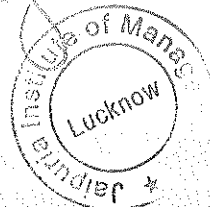
**Brief about the activity:**

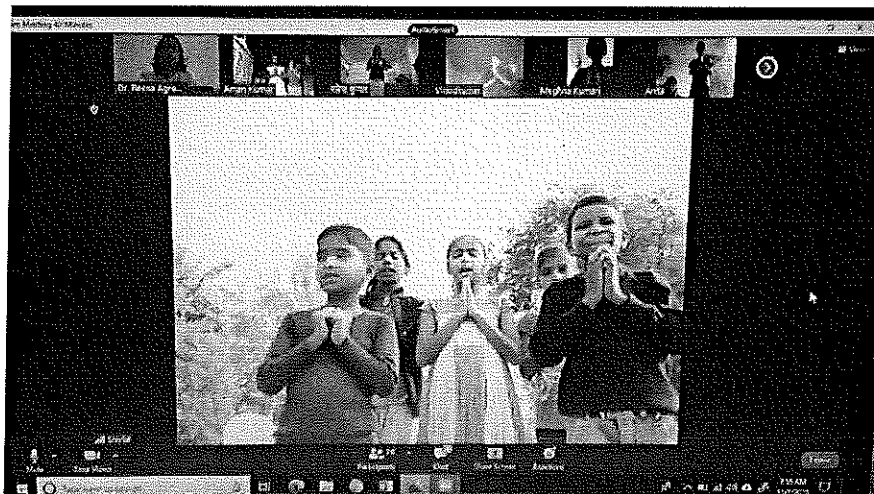
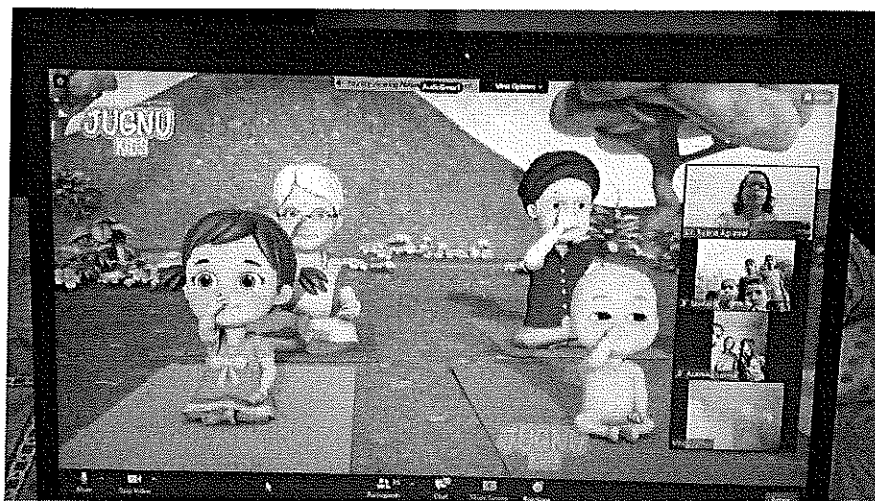

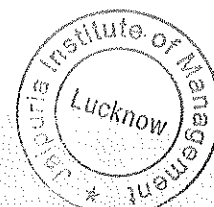

The event was started with a prayer service, followed by a short video on the importance and benefits of Yoga.



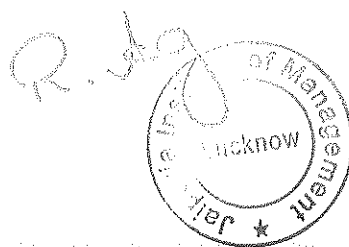
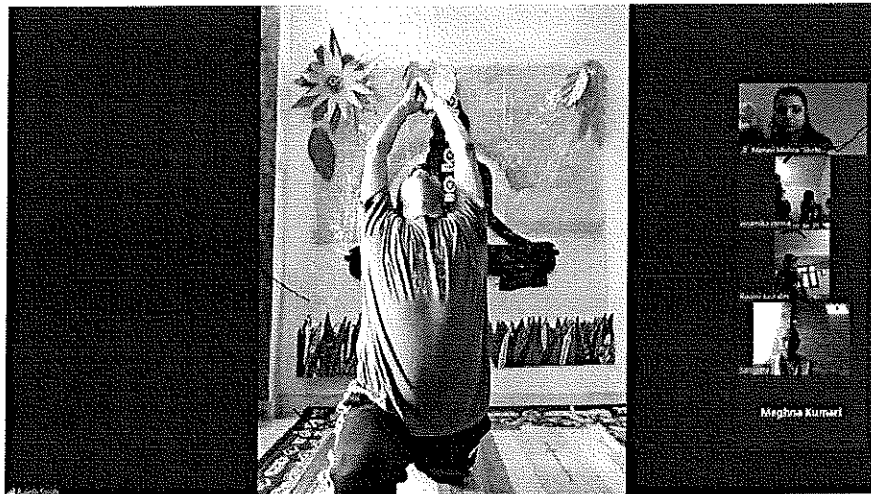

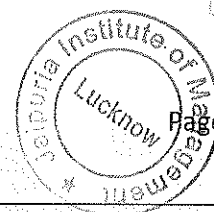
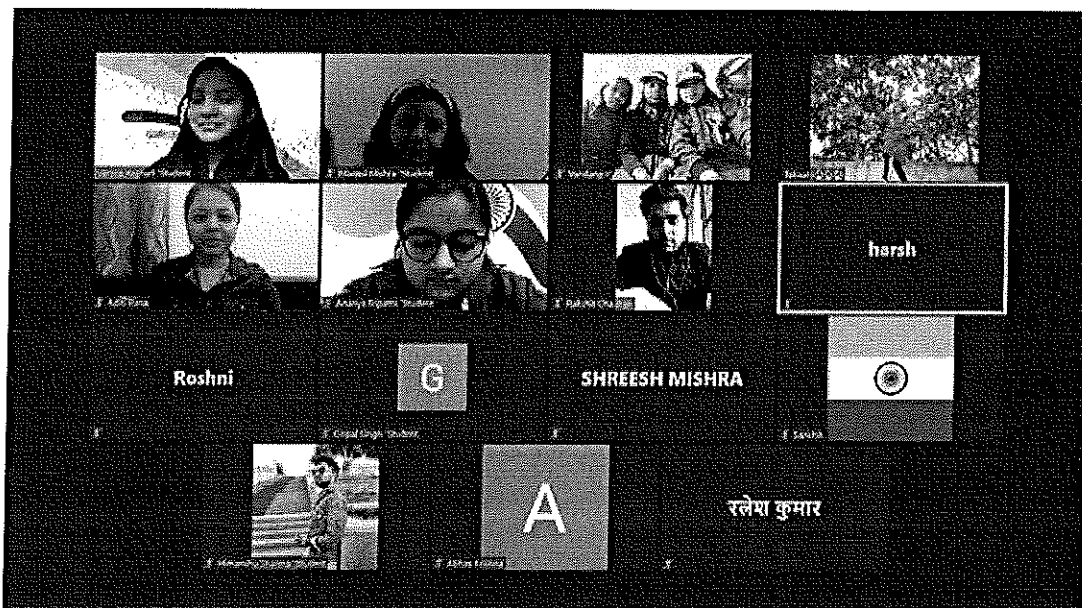
**Nature of activity:** Celebrating National Day

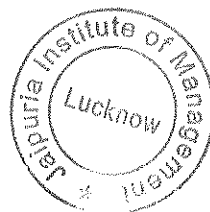
The students at our institute had graciously agreed to volunteer for performing in the event and spending their time with the kids.

Melodious and soothing musical performance was also presented by our team members, **Mr. Himanshu Sharma, Mr. Sanchit** where they sang patriotic songs.

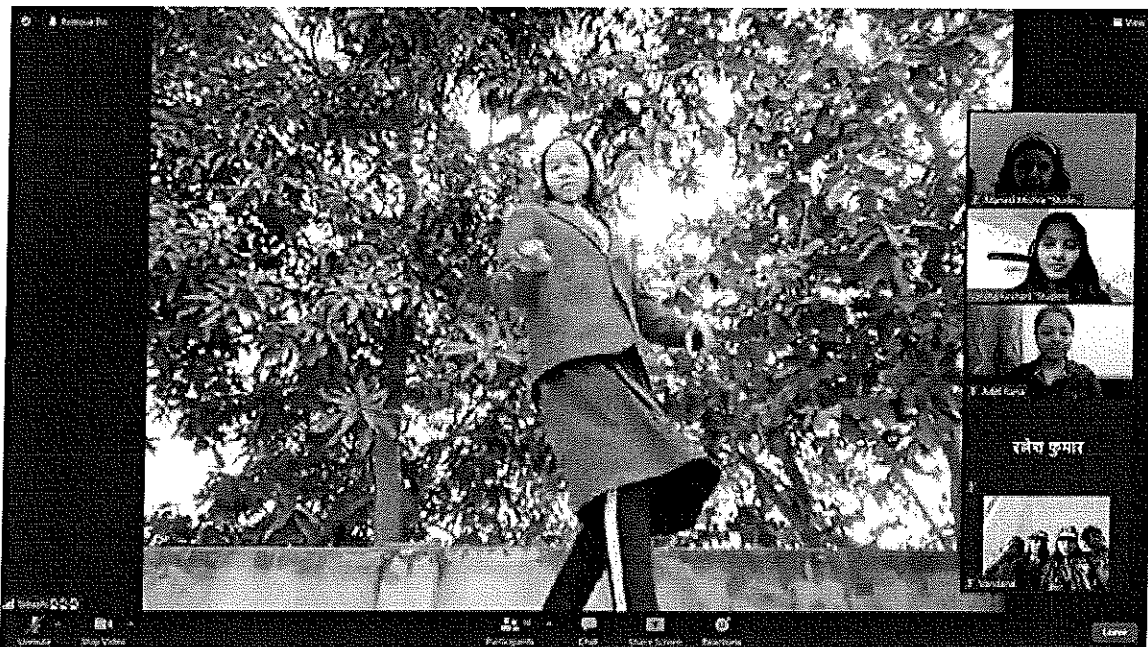

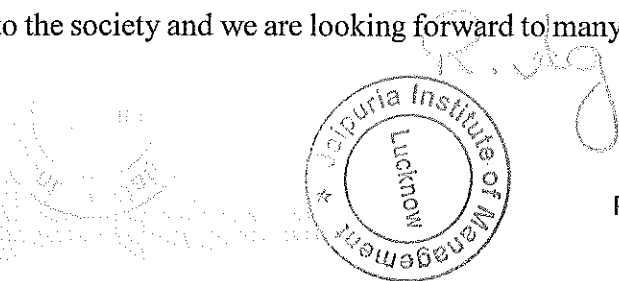

**Brief about the activity:**

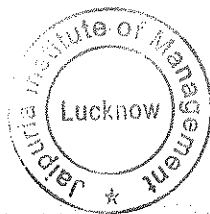
*“What is necessary to change a person is to change his awareness of himself.”*

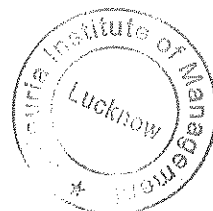
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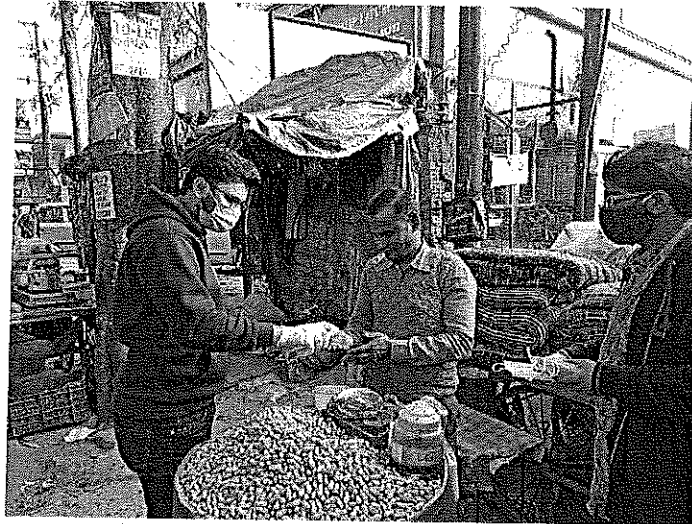
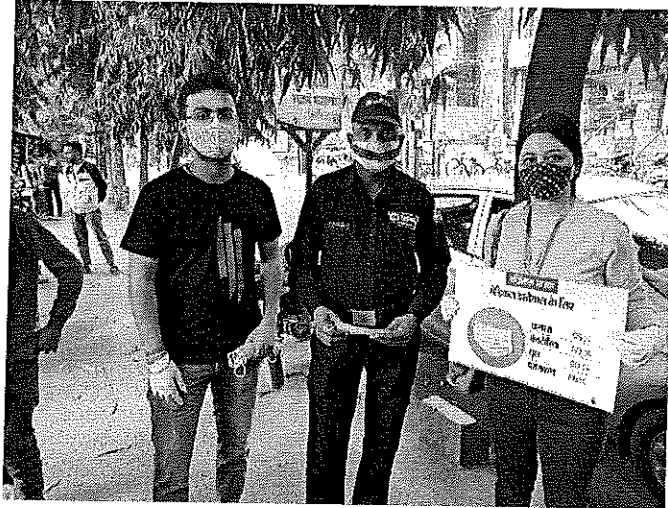

A total of **250 Masks** were distributed in the drive. The team received a very positive response from all those with whom they interacted.

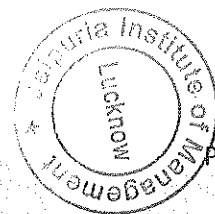

**Nature of activity:** Social service for the underprivileged

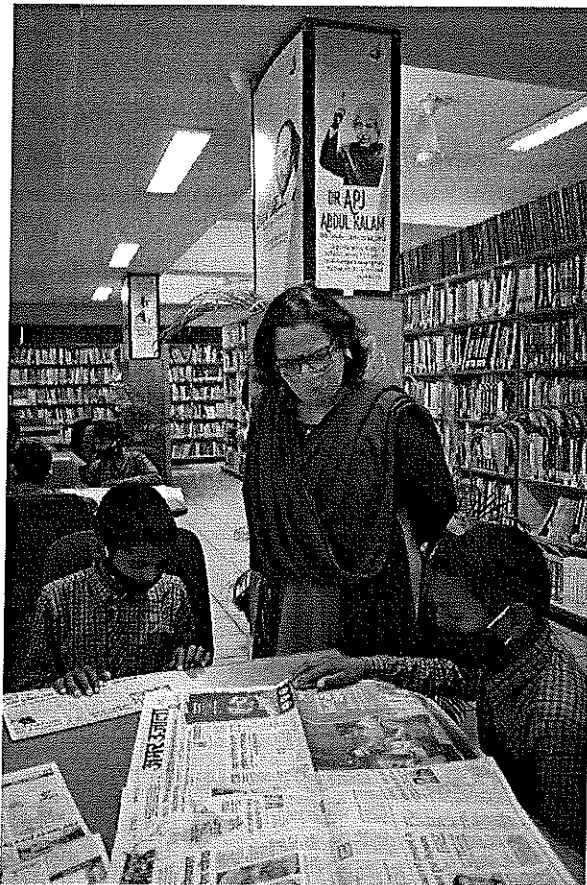
**Brief about the activity:**

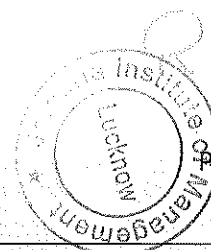

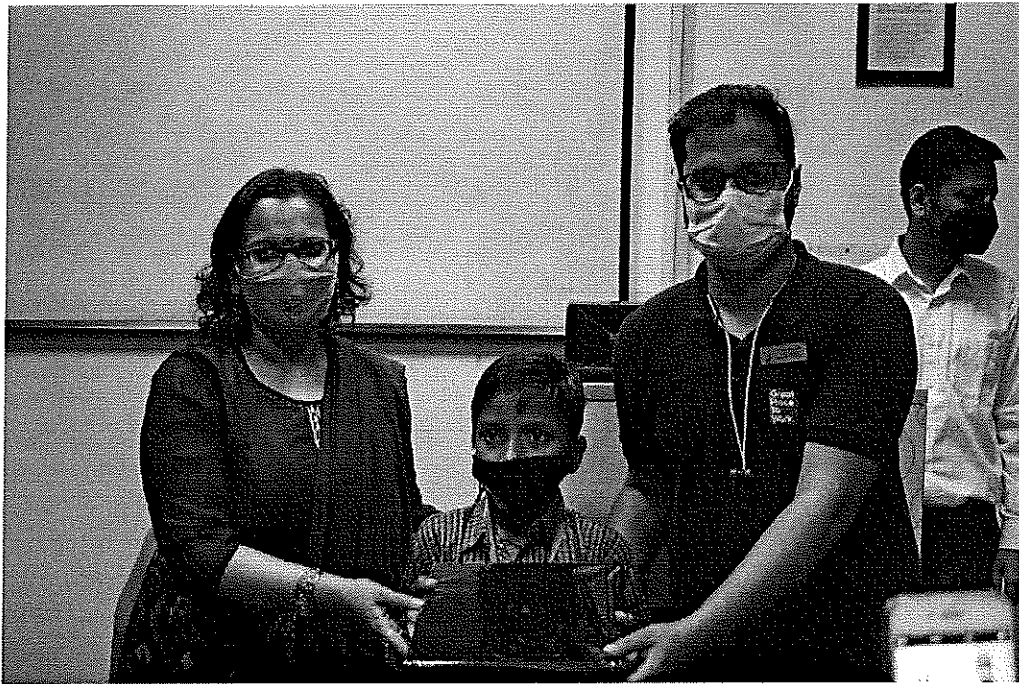
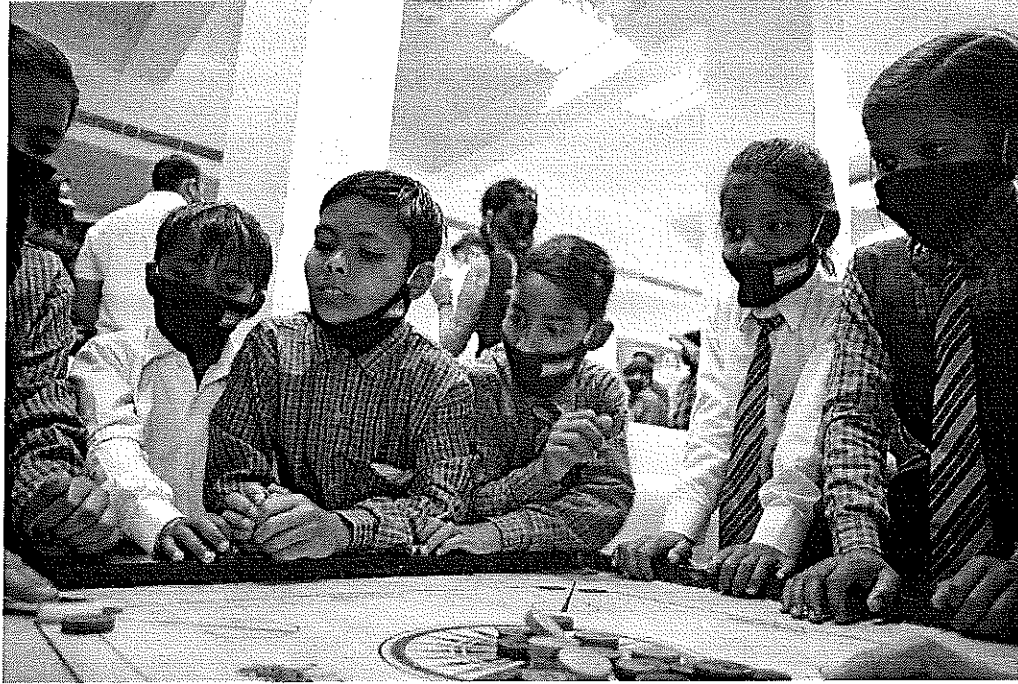
present to welcome the students. Proper sanitization facilities were provided, and social distancing was maintained.



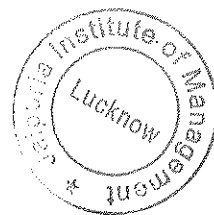

The story which was narrated by both of them, actually brought cold shivers within the audience. The people were so touched by the bravery of Rani Laxmi Bai.



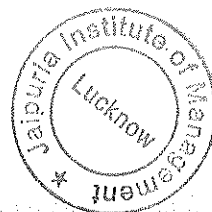

## COVID-19 WARRIORS

**Nature of activity:** Social work

**Brief about the activity:**

During the second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic, **Dr. Reena Agrawal, Chairperson, Social Responsibility Committee, Jaipuria Institute of Management Lucknow**, made it her mission to reach out to as many people as she could and help them. For this purpose, not only did she approach her students from the present batches, but alumnus of the institute passed out even 15 years ago. With her wide network of students and other contacts in various NGO, she has been running the program currently for almost 2.5 weeks now. In this short span of time the team has been able to provide leads to **1000+ critically ill Covid patients All Over India**, regarding their requirement for **hospital beds, oxygen cylinders & concentrators, essential medicines, blood & plasma donors, doctors, food, and ambulance services.**

The team is led by **Mr. Shobhit Tandon (2012-2014 batch, JIML)** and **Mr. Ankur Bhatia (2009-2011 batch, JIML)**. Under their efficient leadership, the turnaround time for responding to queries is 2 minutes, and the team is working round the clock.


**Mgmt students, professionals turn saviours, use tech to mobilise help for Covid patients**

**Lucknow:** A man looking for a plasma donor for his 63-year-old father in Noida, took to social media to post an SOS message. Within no time, he got a list of verified plasma donors, thanks to a group of strangers who have helped more than 300 people desperately looking for oxygen cylinders, hospital beds, plasma and medicines.

"Saving lives is the need of the hour. Apart from sharing initial leads, we also ask patients to remain in touch with us till they get help," said 38-year-old Shobhit Tandon, a financial consultant from Kanpur.

The team, constituted by a management faculty in Lucknow, gets requisitions on WhatsApp groups following which the team uses social media to

ring leads. There are people who offer assistance immediately. Such is the power of humanity in times of crisis," said Reena Agrawal. As the woman behind the initiative.

Agrawal, who heads the social responsibility committee in a management institute, contacted her students and alumni of last 10 years, now working in different sectors across the country. "We have three WhatsApp groups where over 600 volunteers are connected. It's heart-burming to see people responding in record time. The USP of our team is that we are working in shifts round the clock," Agrawal told TOI.

In a recent case, the team used social media to help a patient from Tirupat get a bed. "We got the message that a person needs a bed in Tirupat. When we searched, we found that no bed was vacant. Within an hour, we arranged for a bed in a hospital in an adjoining district roughly two hours away from Tirupat. We even arranged an ambulance for him, and everything was done online," Shobhit said.

"The entire movement is by the people and for the people. The second wave of pandemic has left us so helpless that we decided to do our bit. Every time we save a life, we feel happy and motivated," said 36-year-old Aditi Rana, a first-year management student.

For Ankur Bhatia (31), a bank employee in Kanpur, the movement has instilled hope in people. "When we came together, we found that lack of information was the biggest hurdle in fight against Covid. We work on providing leads and help people," Ankur said.

In the last two weeks, the team has helped over 100 patients with hospital beds in Lucknow, Delhi, Noida, Gurugram, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Bhopal, Jaipur, Patna, Dehradun, Varanasi and Prayagraj.

"The group has helped more than 125 patients in various cities of the country with medicines and injections. They have arranged plasma for at least 40 patients and provided oxygen cylinders, cans and concentrators to 120 people. The group is also arranging RT-PCR tests and ambulance for patients."

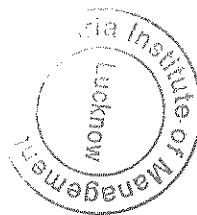

They are informing people all over the internet about our program by taking the help of social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram & WhatsApp. Those in need are contacting us through the platforms and the team is providing them with a solution almost immediately. Also, there are many other pages on social media where people are placing their requests, the team contacts them as well as help them with a solution.

There are 3 WhatsApp groups running by the name of **Jeevan Dhara, Let's be Human & Let's Save Humanity**, with 300+ members, where all the queries are being shared and details are shared with the patient's attendants. Once a query is resolved, the same is updated on the group.

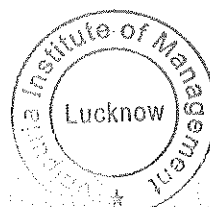

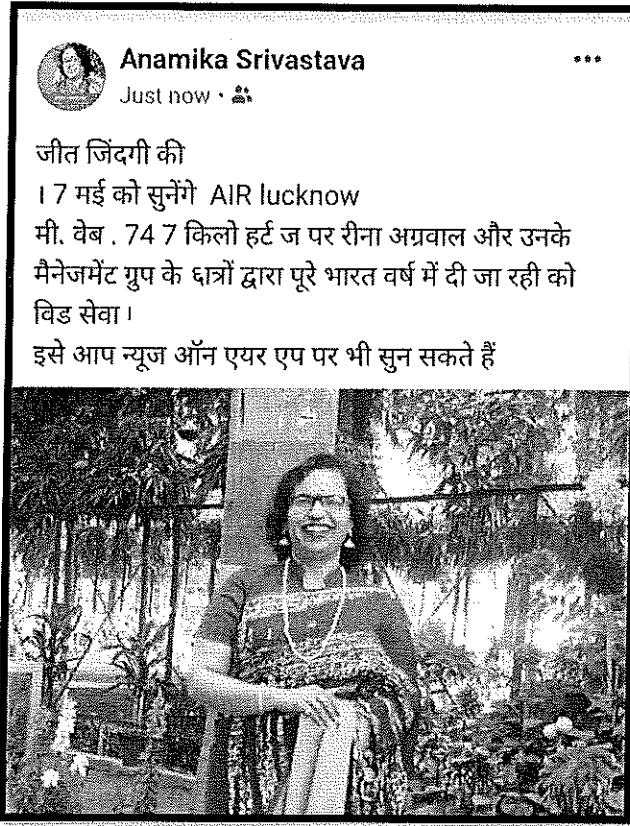
