
International Plastic Bag Free Day at Jaipuria Institute of Management, Lucknow | 3rd July 2021

To mark the importance of the day, first a social media campaign was initiated where the team had shared a poster to be shared with hashtag #PledgeAgainstPlastic.






Being Socially Responsible Say No to Plastic Campaign Phase 2







Being Socially Responsible Say No To Plastic - Campaign Phase 3 18th August, 2018




Being Socially Responsible 'Say No to Plastic' Campaign Phase 4

"Plant trees and bring rain to get rid of summer heat." Tree Plantation Drive at Jaipuria Institute of Management Lucknow |3rd August, 2019



The activity was led by Social Responsibility Committee and was conducted under the guidance of Prof. Reena Agrawal, Faculty Coordinator of SRC.

Mr. Ishnidhi Shrivastava, student Coordinator of Social Responsibility Committee along with his team gathered around the Gomti river bank near Hanuman Setu temple, early in the morning. The whole idea behind the activity was to inculcate the spirit of saving trees and spread awareness about the importance of trees and to sensitise people to the harmful effects of using plastic.


