Event Details:

Rules:

- 1. **Theme:** The theme for this competition is either Fiction or Memes or Anime.
- 2. Your poster should have the heading of the chosen theme and should convey a clear message related to the theme.
- 3. Participation: This is an individual event. You cannot participate in teams.
- 4. Size and Orientation: The size of the poster will be A3 (11.7 x 16.5 inches), and it can be in portrait or landscape orientation. It will be provided by the organizers.
- 5. **Materials:** The poster can be made using a pencil, crayon, watercolor, oil paint, etc (which will NOT be provided by the organizers).
- 6. Photographs, wires, other 3D objects, and printouts won't be acceptable. It should be original and handmade.
- 7. **Submission:** Participants need to submit their posters within the prescribed time by the organizers failing which you can be disqualified.
- 8. **Prizes:** The top three posters will be selected as winners, and they will receive 1 st and 2 nd Prizes respectively.
- 9. **Judging Criteria:** The posters will be judged based on creativity, originality, relevanceto the theme, and overall impact. The rubrics are as follows:
